This is the first in a series of nursing newsletters to educate families on key health protocols adopted by the district to keep staff and students safe. Our hope is to provide families with vital information to prepare students before they begin to enter school and district facilities. As we transition between each phase of re-opening, **please keep in mind that your school nurse is** here to help you navigate the new guidelines around illness and when to keep your child home.

We know that the guidelines can be confusing! Should your student become ill, we will partner with you to determine when your child should stay home **and** when they may return. Please keep your child home when they are ill, even if it seems mild.

In addition to our regular exclusion guidelines, check in with your child daily for the following signs of illness:

 Cough Fever 100.4 or greater Difficulty breathing New loss of taste or smell Chills 	 Sore throat Nasal congestion or runny nose Headache Nausea, vomiting Diarrhea Muscle aches/pains Fatigue
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If any of the above symptoms are present, please keep your child at home and call the attendance line at to report the student out sick. Including the student's symptoms when you contact the school is helpful.

If your child is receiving on-site instruction or participating in activities in the school building **any day of the week**, it is important for you to **notify the school when your child is ill even on virtual learning days.**
