Students who participate in OSAA sports and complete an entire season may be eligible to receive onequarter PE credit (.25) per sport. A student may use two sports seasons during the sophomore, junior and/or senior year to earn a maximum of .5 PE credit. All students are expected to complete .5 credit in PE 1 (usually during 9th grade). The request for PE credit for athletic participation is made in the student's senior year.

Process & Guidelines:

- PE credit may be earned for participation in OSAA sports as an alternative credit option as outlined in district policy, IKA-AR.
- The availability of PE credit for sports participation will be communicated through various means (i.e. student handbooks, curriculum guides, the athletic office, counseling departments).
- Students may not apply for such credit until their senior year.
- Seniors must show a transcript record that demonstrates a full load of classes each semester during high school inclusive of off-campus, district approved programs. Teacher or staff assistant is excluded and will make the student ineligible for consideration of this credit.
- The PE Credit Request form will not be provided if a student does not qualify for any reason listed in the guidelines.
- Qualifying seniors are responsible to have the form completed and presented to the principal for final approval in a timely manner (suggested by the end of the first semester or trimester).
- Such credit is available for participation in OSAA sports by the student in grades 10, 11, or 12 only.
- A maximum total of .5 credit may be earned for sports participation (2 sports seasons @ .25 credits each in either the same or different sports).
- All students are required to complete PE 1 (usually in the 9th grade) for .5 PE credit.
- The coach and athletic director will maintain records of all OSAA teams and their members for their respective teams / schools.
- If the coach is unavailable to verify a student's athletic participation, the athletic director will do so.
- Student must have successfully completed the season in order to receive credit. Successful completion must be verified by the coach or athletic director.
- Credit will be recorded as P (Pass) grade. Letter grades (A F) not will be issued.
- Any one of the items listed below will make the student ineligible to receive credit under this option:
 - Any violation of the Bend La Pine Schools Participation & Training Contract will make the student ineligible for credit in that sport season.
 - Students must be academically eligible for the entire season to be eligible for credit.
 - Seniors must show a transcript record that demonstrates a full load of classes each semester during high school inclusive of off-campus, district approved programs. Teacher or staff assistant is excluded and will make the student ineligible for consideration of this credit.
 - Serving as a student trainer, statistician, or manager for a sports team will not qualify for PE credit.

Participation in the following OSAA sports will be considered for PE credit during a student's time in grades 10, 11, and 12:

Students interested in obtaining credit for activities other than those listed above should apply through the Alternative Learning Experience process as described in IKA-AR. More information is available from the counseling departments at the high schools or through district administrative regulation.

Bend-La Pine Schools provide high school students the opportunity to earn part of their PE requirements through participation in OSAA sports. Successful participation in a sports season during grades 10, 11, & 12 may qualify a student for .25 credit in PE. Up to .5 PE credit (for two sports seasons) may be earned in this manner. All students are expected to complete the required PE 1 course for .5 credit (usually during 9th grade).

Requirements:

- Application for such credit is to be made during the student's 12th grade (senior) year (suggested by the end of the first semester/trimester).
- Available for participation in OSAA sports in grades 10 12 only.
- A maximum total of .5 PE credit may be earned for sports participation.
- All students are required to complete PE 1 for .5 PE credit (usually in the 9th grade).
- Student must successfully complete the season in order to receive credit. Successful completion must be verified by the Coach or Athletic Director.
- Credit will be recorded as P grade (Pass). Letter grades (A F) not will be issued.
- Any one of the items listed below will make the student ineligible to receive credit in this program:
 - Any violation of the Bend La Pine Schools Participation & Training Contract will make the student ineligible for credit in that sport season.
 - Students must be academically eligible for the entire season to be eligible for credit.
 - Seniors must show a transcript record that demonstrates a full load of classes each semester during high school inclusive of off-campus, district approved programs. Teacher or staff assistant is excluded and will make the student ineligible for consideration of this credit.
 - Serving as a student trainer, statistician, or manager for a sports team will not qualify for PE credit.
