Inclement Weather Guidelines

Bend-La Pine Schools will continue to offer instructional services to **most** of our students during inclement weather conditions, allowing them to keep pace with their academic studies and avoid make-up days at the end of the school year.

During inclement weather events all BLS buildings will be closed to the public, bus routes will not run, and the following activities will be canceled: in-person learning, meal service, onsite childcare, and all afternoon/evening activities.

Here's what to expect on inclement weather days, based on the learning model your students' are enrolled in:

All-in Instruction

Students receiving all-in instruction (all schools grades K-3, some schools grades 4-5) will follow regular inclement weather guidelines: Schools will be closed for in-person learning and will not provide remote instruction. Most students in these grades will not be taking devices home, so teachers will not be able to provide remote instruction.

Balanced/Hybrid Instruction

During Balanced/Hybrid learning, approximately half the students will be scheduled to be at home while half will be scheduled to be at school. The half scheduled to be at home will continue as planned. The half scheduled to go to school will stay at home and teachers will make assignments available through their learning management system (Google Classrooms for Grades 4-5 and Canvas for grades 6-12) prior to 11 a.m.. Teachers and specialists will be available during the day to provide remote support to students.

District Comprehensive Distance Learning

Instruction to students in the District CDL program will continue operating on schedule.

Site or Classroom Distance Learning

If sites or classrooms are in quarantine, they will be in a distance learning model. These sites or classrooms will continue to operate during an inclement weather day.
