HIV, AIDS AND HBV - HEALTH EDUCATION

An HIV/AIDS/HBV curriculum shall be developed cooperatively by parents, teachers, administration, local health department staff and others.

The curriculum shall present current, accurate information to help students learn infection control for preventing the spread of the HIV/AIDS/HBV-causing virus and to assist them in making decisions about protecting their health and the health of others. The curriculum shall stress the value of abstinence. Information about HIV, AIDS and HBV infections shall be included in the curriculum.

The Board shall adopt the curriculum.

The age-appropriate curriculum shall be taught annually in grades K-12.

All Schools will be accountable for notifying parents prior to instruction on human sexuality, AIDS, HBV or HIV. Schools are responsible for documentation of parent notification.

Notification will include the parents rights to review the material and that no pupil shall be required to take or participate in any instruction on human sexuality or human immunodeficiency virus if the parent or guardian, after having reviewed the materials, submits written objection to the school district.

Method of notification may include: Newsletter

Parent letter

Permission Forms

Personal I Contact (electronic mail, telephone, electronic message service, etc.)

Parent Meeting

All schools are responsible for providing alternative health education for credit, for those students whose parents have requested that they be excluded from instruction on human sexuality, AIDS, HBV or human immunodeficiency virus. The curriculum will be comprehensive and meet the adopted health standards.

Parents of minor students shall be notified in advance that the material regarding AIDS/HIV/HBV will be taught. Any parent may request his/her student be excused from the class under the provisions set forth in Oregon Revised Statutes and Administrative Rules.
