LOGGING IN



Parents should get their own account:

*You can then access additional information (rather than using StudentVue)

*You can also have the capability to change information (emails, phone numbers, etc.)

LOOKING AT THE GRADES



1. Click on GRADEBOOK on the left side
2. Click on the class you would like to see your child's progress/scores in
3. There is currently a glitch, but know you will want to be in STANDARDS VIEW which can be toggled in the upper right hand corner.
4. Consider the standards your child is being assessed on and choose one at a time to see any assignments that correspond to that standard
5. Scores that demonstrate proficiency will be in GREEN
6. Scores in RED demonstrate that more work is needed to reach proficiency.

SOME GENERAL TIPS



1. Check regularly. Set up a weekly/bi-weekly appointment to sit with your child and review their progress
2. Have your child take you into their Google Classroom accounts where many teachers post assignment, projects, etc.
3. Urge your child to take advantage of Mountain Time for additional support and retakes on low assessments.
