

How to support your child in Spanish

1. If they have low grades...
 - a. Check parent / student view to see what assignments are 1s and 2s. Those assignments can be found in google classroom, posted by date. Warm ups are in the daily material. Homework is abbreviated HW and is posted as an assignment.
 - b. Students should correct any homework or warm ups where they scored 1s or 2s. Then, they can come to Mountain Time, correct their tests and retake a different version of the test when they are ready.

2. If students need help with homework
 - a. Go to Google classroom or the “notes” section of the app, Notability. There, you can find “pink sheets” on the content they are studying for Spanish 1a and 1b. Spanish 2 students have the Pearson textbook on their I-pads.
 - b. Homework is practice of what we have been studying recently. Students can use their warm ups and class activities as resources. The original assignments can be found in Google Classroom. The student’s work can be found in their binders and/or Notability.

3. If students need more practice at home with writing, listening, vocabulary recall, etc...
 - a. Go to Google Classroom and find the syllabus and website link.
 - b. On my website, find the tab additional resources. Here, there are many helpful websites. One of the most helpful is Quizlet.
 - c. Students can use the “spell” tab on Quizlet to type what they hear, giving them listening practice.
 - d. Students can use the Quizlets I post in Google Classroom or they can search others. They may want to search by textbook name, “Realidades” and Chapter. They can also search by content theme. For example: Spanish calendar
