ACB-BP: Every Student Belongs	In February 2021, amendments to (OAR) 581-022-2312 were adopted, including changing the title to Every Student Belongs. In May 2021, the Oregon Legislature adopted House Bill 2697, which placed many of the same requirements into statute. Finally, in October 2021, the OAR was amended again to more closely align with the legislative action.	4/12/2022
ACB-AR: Bias Incident Complaint Procedure	Defines process and response efforts of the district when bias incidents are reported as defined in OAR 581-022-2312.	1/11/2022

Executive Limitation 12: Legally Required Policies	Clarification on the review and adoption process for policy and regulations. Naming scheme updated to include Board Policy (BP), Administrative Policy (AP) and Administrative Regulation (AR).	12/14/2021
FFA-AR: Memorials	Provides clarity and process for establishing permanent and temporary memorials on district property as well as requests for memorials at school sponsored events.	5/10/2022
FKA-AR: Guidelines for Volunteer Facility Improvement Projects	Updated to include reference to FFA-AR: Memorials. Review process for projects has also been updated to match current district practices.	6/21/2022
GBJ-BP: Weapons in Schools (Staff)	Alignment with KGBB-BP and provisions set forth in SB 554 (2021). Renamed from Administrative Policy (AP) to Board Policy (BP).	12/14/2021 & 6/21/2022
GCAB-AP: Social Media Use & Expectations	GCAB-AP facilitates the effective use of social media to further the educational goals of the district while ensuring proper safeguards. This policy applies to Bend-La Pine students, employees, volunteers, contractors, and other personnel acting in an official capacity on behalf of BLS.	6/21/2022
GCDA/GDDA-AP: Criminal Records Check / Fingerprinting	Updated language provides district discretion when determining to restrict volunteer status. Policy has also been renamed from a Board Policy (BP) to Administrative Policy (AP).	4/12/2022

GCDA/GDDA-AR: Criminal Records Check / Fingerprinting	Updates have been made to align with current district practice and processes defined by the Oregon Department of Education (ODE).	4/12/2022
GP-3: Board Code of Conduct	Addition of social media account responsibilities and suggested guidelines of use for Board members who choose to have social media account(s). Suggested language aligns with GCAB-AP.	6/21/2022
GP-5: Board Member Roles	Clarification of chairperson term length as well as reference to ORS 332.040 for board election of officers.	6/21/2022
GP-6: Governance Process	Updates include the process for prioritizing speakers for public comment during meetings, clarifying the time allotted for public comment during meetings, and majority voting requirement.	11/9/2021 & 6/21/2022
IIA-AR: Instructional Materials Selection	Alignment of process and practices currently taking place in Bend-La Pine Schools.	10/12/2021
IICA-AR: Field Trips and Special Activities	Clarification that all out of state travel requests that are sponsored by the school or district must be approved by the Superintendent.	1/11/2022
INB-AP: Studying Controversial Issues	New policy to provide context and purpose for studying controversial issues. The corresponding INB-AR, reviews the detail and process of material selection.	10/12/2021
INB-AR: Studying Controversial Issues Process	Clarification of the process used when studying controversial issues and selecting supplemental materials.	
JECAC-AR: Parental Custody	Clarification that Bend-La Pine Schools may seek guidance from district legal counsel when dealing with parental custody issues and that the district requires a court order to be signed or stamped by a judicial official.	9/14/2021
JFCA-AR: Student Code of Dress	Last revised in 2004, the recommended updates include more inclusive language and clarification of the goals and values Bend-La Pine Schools seeks to uphold in regard to student dress.	10/12/2021
JFCJ-BP: Weapons in Schools (Students)	Alignment with KGBB-BP and provisions set forth in SB 554 (2021). Renamed from Administrative Policy (AP) to Board Policy (BP).	12/14/2021
KCA-AP: Volunteers in Schools	Reviewed to ensure policy is in alignment with current district practice. Includes reference that volunteers in schools must follow newly adopted, KGBB-BP: Firearms Prohibited.	4/12/2022
KCA-AR: Volunteers/Criminal History Records Check	Reviewed to ensure regulation is in alignment with current district practice. Updates include COVID-19 vaccination and/or exemption requirements that volunteers must provide per Oregon Health Authority (OHA) guidance, as well as reference to newly adopted, KGBB-BP: Firearms Prohibited.	4/12/2022
KGBB-BP: Firearms Prohibited	Senate Bill (SB) 554 (2021) allows districts to prohibit even those with concealed carry licenses from carrying firearms by adopting a policy and posting notice at entry points.	12/14/2021
KK-AR: Visitors to District Facilities	Updated language includes reference to newly adopted, KGBB-BP: Firearms Prohibited and provides district discretion when determining to restrict visitor access to district facilities.	4/12/2022
KL-AR: Public Complaints	Timeline and process for complaints made against a board member have been included.	12/14/2021
KL-BP: Public Complaints	Timeline and process for investigation and response when a complaint is made against a board member.	12/14/2021
