- Begin scholarship search
- Begin college application process

- Complete Oregon Student Assistance Commission (OSAC) scholarship application

FEBRUARY

- Counselors will meet with seniors who are in jeopardy of not graduating
- Apply for Oregon Promise if you will attend an Oregon Community College - 2.5 GPA required
- Follow up to colleges, make sure your application & supplemental information is complete and has been received
- Send mid-year reports to colleges, if necessary
- Notification to students who are credit deficient for graduation
- Observe scholarship deadlines (12/1/19 - 3/1/20 for many Oregon state colleges)

MARCH

- 3/1: Last day to submit OSAC and Oregon Promise Application - details in Future Center
- 3/13: Deadline for those using a payment plan for rings, announcements - Miners Grad Services
- Notification of regular admission college acceptance begins
- Progress Reports: Parents of seniors with a D or F receive notice
- Research and complete applications for local scholarships
- TBD: English and Math Placement Exam for COCC - details in Future Center

APRIL

- Check on grades being sent to SHS from online and district courses
- Sign-ups begin for COCC placement testing at SHS (April or May)
- Attend Admitted Student Day events at campuses you've selected
- Before MAY 1 compare college acceptances and financial aid packages. Make school selection!
- Send your selected college a notification and any required deposit
 - Notify other colleges that you will not be attending
- 4/1: Public/student accessible enrollment portal closes
- 4/1 at 11am: Senior Class Meeting - distribution of Grad Announcements: Auditorium
- 4/2 from 12:36 - 1:15pm: Summit student job fair - details in the Future Center

JUNE & END OF YEAR INFORMATION

- 6/1 by Noon: Teachers to report any failing seniors. Seniors must be passing all required classes needed for graduation to participate in the commencement ceremony. This includes COCC and online verification.
- 6/1: All senior grades reported
- 6/2 at 9:55AM: Senior Awards Assembly in the GYM - wear grad gown
- 6/3: SENIOR CHECK OUT AND LAST DAY OF SCHOOL
- FINAL TRANSCRIPT REQUEST is part of the check-out process
- 6/3 at 1pm: Senior BBQ at Summit
- **6/4 at TBD: COMMENCEMENT REHEARSAL at Deschutes Co. Fairgrounds**
 - **ARRIVE TO BOARD THE BUSES NO LATER THAN TBD**
 - **BUSES WILL DEPART SUMMIT AT TBD**
- 6/4: Directly after Commencement: Senior Party. Details to come from Summit Boosters
- 6/4 at 7PM: COMMENCEMENT at Deschutes County Fairgrounds
 - Doors open at 6pm
- GRADUATION BUSING INFORMATION - Thursday, June 4th:
 - Seniors will only ride buses TO the ceremony - they will need a ride home after commencement OR take the grad party buses
 - 5:30PM: Arrive and load buses at SHS
 - 6:00PM: Depart SHS for Fairgrounds
 - 6:30PM: Arrive to Fairgrounds - back entrance

SENIOR AND NON-SENIOR MUSICIANS will ride music buses to the Fairgrounds for Commencement. The Music buses will depart Summit near the Band Room at **TBD.**
