



Forecasting Tips for Juniors

1. Have you checked your total credits? You must have **19** completed credits by the end of your junior year in order to graduate with our **26 credit diploma**. You should have completed:

- 3.0 Language Arts
 - 3.0 Math (starting at Algebra 1 level)
 - 3.0 Science
 - 1.0 Modern World History
 - 1.0 US History
 - 2.0 PE and Health
 - 3.0 FA credits (language, tech, art)
 - And OTHERS
- Total must be 19 or more**

If you haven't successfully completed these courses be sure to speak with your counselor, sign-up to take them during your senior year, or investigate credit recovery options (if you've failed one of the above courses).

2. Are you aware of alternate credit options? Expanded Options, Work Study, School to Career, and online opportunities are all viable credit sources.

3. Do you need to take another **ACT?** (act.org) or another **SAT?** (collegeboard.org)

4. Do you need to update your contact information? Have you moved? Do your parents have a new phone number or email? Let Julie Plummer know ASAP.

5. Seek out leadership opportunities in your clubs and activities. Attend college visitations at Summit, research scholarship opportunities in the Future Center, and attend the college fair in October.

6. Start thinking about letters of recommendation. Will you need one? Give recommenders **at least 3 weeks notice!** Please see your counselor for proper guidelines in the counseling department.

7. Know your college's admission requirements and deadlines! Are you playing sports in college? If so, make sure you are registered with NCAA.

Online Forecasting

You will be able to choose your classes online through StudentVue. Please remember that all class offerings are contingent on staffing and enrollment. Be sure to select at least 3 alternates in case you don't get your first choices.

You can choose your classes online beginning on Feb. 22nd.

**You need to have your classes picked by
FRIDAY, MARCH 10th.**

You CAN pick your classes with your iPad but it only works using Safari - it does not work on the app for your phone.

To use your iPad, open Safari and type in this url: <https://sv.bend.sis.k12.or.us>

To pick your classes, follow these instructions:

Log into your **StudentVue** account.

Select ***course request button*** on left hand side.

To **add** a course select ***click here to change course requests***.

To **search** for a class, type in the course ID or the course name and click ***search courses***. For year-long classes you will need **2 course codes** - one for each semester.

You may choose **request** or **alternative** to add the course.

You may select the **remove** button to remove a course.

Total for selected courses must be enough to complete your graduation requirements.

Total for alternative courses may not exceed **2.0** credits

Please be sure the course codes you select match the course codes you've filled in on your forecast sheet!
